HYDRO ETIQUETTE

Please assist us in making your Hydro experience unforgettable by following these guidelines when making use of The Hydro facilities. Please respect and treat all facilities with care and show consideration for other guests. Report any misbehavior to the Life Guard or Security Officer on duty. Failure to comply with the etiquette may result in the immediate eviction of the offenders.

Entrance:

- Free for resident guests wearing the correct I.D. bracelet. On the day of departure Resort Residents may make use of The Hydro until 16:00, but need to pay the normal day visitors fee from 17:00.
- Day visitors can also make use of The Hydro pools by paying a separate fee for each session.
- Senior Citizens: (persons from 60 years of age or presentation of a SASSA Card), qualify for a discounted rate.

Rheumatism pool:

- Due to the health risk posed by the high temperature of the water pregnant ladies, children and persons suffering from high blood pressure and heart problems should avoid the rheumatism pool.
- It is recommended that you should not spend more than 20 minutes in the rheumatism pool *and drink lots of water to avoid dehydration.*

General:

- No music and no loud, excessive or rowdy behavior are allowed in The Hydro.
- No alcoholic drinks or glass bottles are allowed at The Hydro. Persons that have consumed alcohol may be denied access to The Hydro.
- Food may only be consumed at the outdoor tables.
- Splashing, jumping and playing with balls or Frisbees are prohibited. No big pool toys are allowed.
- For hygienic reasons only custom-made swimwear is allowed in The Hydro pools. A T-shirt and ski pants may be worn with swimwear but no other clothing will be allowed in the pool.
- The whole Hydro complex is a smoke free area. This includes all indoor and outdoor areas.
- Please don't leave your personal belongings unattended. Lockers are available at The Hydro pools. Guests could either bring their own padlock or purchase a padlock at The Hydro entrance.

THE HYDRO & CHILDREN

- Parents of Children under the age of (3) three should be aware of the health risks involved with small children making use of the Hydro pools. The high temperatures and humidity pose a health risk and can cause fits. Young children are also prone to rapid dehydration and heat exhaustion. Furthermore, the absorption of high-density minerals as it is present in the hydro pool may cause damage to the frail livers and kidneys of children. This damage may only become apparent later in life.
- Please don't leave your children unattended, as this could be disruptive to other Guests and unsafe to your children. An adult should accompany children under the age of 16.
- Only swimming nappies are allowed in the pool and all children have to wear tight fitting, custom-made swimwear.
- Because of the health risk posed by the high temperature of the water, children should avoid the Rheumatism pool.
